

FINDING RELEVANT BOOKS IN EBRARY ON THE LIBRARY WEBPAGE

- SIGN ONTO BLACKBOARD
- CLICK ON LIBRARY TAB
- CLICK ON “Research|Explore” on Library WebPage
 - Click on “e-books”
 - Under “Books”, click on “ebrary Academic Complete”
- FIND “SIMPLE SEARCH” BOX ON EBRARY HOMEPAGE
- USING ONE OF YOUR FAVORITE TOPICS IN CLASS, TYPE KEYWORDS IN SEARCH BOX AND CLICK ON “SEARCH EBRARY”
- TITLE RESULTS AND NUMBER OF BOOK RESULTS WILL APPEAR - YOU MAY CHOOSE AT THIS POINT TO NARROW YOUR SEARCH OR SIMPLY LOOK THROUGH TITLES
- IF YOU DECIDE TO NARROW YOUR SEARCH, SEE SELECTED SUBJECTS UNDER SEARCH BOX AND CLICK ON THOSE YOU CHOOSE AND THEN CLICK ON “SEARCH EBRARY”
- FIND THREE BOOKS NO MORE THAN FIVE YEARS OLD IN THE LIST OF BOOKS
- “OPEN A BOOK” BY CLICKING ON THE TITLE OR JACKET – DO THIS FOR EACH OF THE THREE BOOKS YOU HAVE CHOSEN
- EXPLORE THE DOCUMENT BY CONTINUING TO SEARCH WITH THE SEARCH BOX, LOOK THROUGH THE TABLE OF CONTENTS, JUMP TO RELEVANT CHAPTERS AND FLIP THROUGH PAGES USING FORWARD AND BACKWARD ARROWS
- FOR EACH OF THE THREE BOOKS YOU HAVE CHOSEN, WRITE THE FOLLOWING:
